MAGIC BUS INDIA FOUNDATION

Our partnership will enable higher secondary students to receive career guidance, 1-1 counselling, financial literacy, digital literacy/security sessions, and given access to online life skills sessions content. Students who have passed out of school will be part of an 8-week skilling programme to equip them with core life skills, workplace readiness, financial literacy, IT and spoken English skills. The students will also be placed through Magic Bus' post-placement support programme for up to 6 months, and via Magic Bus Information Advice and Guidance (IAG) process, youth placed in jobs will be extended support as well.



SAMARTHANAM TRUST FOR THE DISABLED

Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled works for the empowerment of persons with disabilities and the underserved through its diverse initiatives. They are focused on providing quality education, accommodation, nutritious food, vocational training and placement-based rehabilitation. Through the residential 'Skill training for aspiring women blind cricketers', program, women with disabilities, primarily visual impairment, will undergo life skills training along with their cricket coaching.



TECHNOLOGY INFORMATICS DESIGN ENDEAVOUR (TIDE)

In its 26-year journey, TIDE has been promoting sustainable development through innovative technological interventions. Building on its work in various aspects of conservation with school children, TIDE has formally launched school programs to create awareness, provide knowledge and set up clean tech interventions at schools. In partnership with SG GSC, the Model School Programme aims to integrate holistic learning, conservation, meaningful civic engagement, with a focus on environmentally friendly technologies.



FOUNDATION FOR EXCELLENCE INDIA TRUST

Founded in 1994, FFE aims to provide college scholarships to students who, although financially constrained, showed great promise in the technological, engineering and medical fields.

Through this partnership, students can pursue their dreams of professional education in Engineering/Technology (BE/B.Tech) and will be granted a scholarship for four years.



VIDYA INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT FOR YOUTH AND ADULTS

VIDYA is a 35-year old NGO, which works towards education, empowerment and transformation of underprivileged children, youth and women by providing holistic education through schools, collaborations and community programs. The VIDYA Scholarship Program in partnership with SG GSC provides scholarship support for underprivileged students to continue their pre-university, undergraduate, engineering and diploma courses.



USHA SCHOOL OF ATHLETICS

The Usha School of Athletics is an NGO set up by one of India's finest track athletes Ms. PT Usha, in association with Ministry of Sports and Youth Affairs in 2002. The school has 20 girl students as part of the 'Athlete Support Program', to promote grassroots sports among young athletes belonging to rural and underprivileged backgrounds.



TALENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - IIT MADRAS

Since 2016, the talent scholarship program at SG GSC has sponsored higher education programs at Tier-1 universities. Currently, the program supports the scholarship of students from the 2017 batch pursuing their B.Tech/Dual degree programme.



SAYTREES ENVIRONMENTAL TRUST

Through the partnership with Societe Generale's global solution centre in India, NGO partner SayTrees will rejuvenate the 50-acre Nallurhalli lake, along with urban afforestation. The lake will be rejuvenated to support and enable a thriving lake ecosystem and provide protection from further damage and encroachment. The condition of the lake will be improved along with public access with a walking track and other amenities.
